Mr. Edhy Prabowo to congratulate on the occasion of ascending to the new Minister of Marine Affairs and Fisheries, and of the commemoration of 70 years relationship Indonesia-Thailand in 2020.

In addition, the meeting also discussed about the signing in Joint Communique on Voluntary International Cooperation to Combat IUU and to Promote Sustainable Fisheries Governance, and pushing forward the ASEAN general fisheries policy including the cooperation of waste disposal in the ocean, the import of lobster larvae in order to feed in Thailand to respond needs both in the country and overseas.
